Ahmad Thomson, Barrister

Profile: Ahmad Thomson was born in Chipata, Zambia. He commenced his formal education in Zimbabwe and completed his studies in England. He embraced Islam in 1973. A member of Gray's Inn and called to the Bar in 1979, Ahmad Thomson is a practising barrister, specialising mainly in Islamic, Charity, Employment and Discrimination Law. He is a founding member of the Association of Muslim Lawyers (UK) and of Muslim Lawyers (Europe). He is the author of several books including *The Difficult Journey*, *The Way Back*, *Making History*, *Jesus, Prophet of Islam* and *Blood on the Cross*, *The Last Prophet* and co-author of *The Islamic Will*.
