

MPF Statement on Terror Attacks in London

The Muslim Professionals Forum (MPF) extend their deepest condolences and prayers for the victims and families of the horrific terror attacks in London last night which left 7 people killed and 48 injured. We are shocked and saddened by these attacks on innocent Londoners.

The attack which also took place during the month of Ramadan, the month of peace and worship where many Muslims devoted themselves in prayers and charity, showed that those who committed these atrocities, are not true followers of any peaceful religion nor do they value the sanctity of human life.

The MPF commend the Metropolitan Police and emergency services who have worked with utmost professionalism to keep Londoners safe; acted swiftly to restrain the attackers, save lives and bring the injured to recover. We urge all community leaders and charitable organisations to work closely with the authorities to apprehend those responsible and their accomplice to be faced with the full force of law.

We also highlight that the times like these that the community needs to come together for the common goal of good and stand together in times of crisis.
